This portable microphone comes with multiple cords and can connect directly to your iPhone, iPad, Mac or PC. It also comes with a mic stand and a headphone jack is built directly into the microphone.

Windscreen

AT2020

The Audio-Technica 2020 is a condenser microphone that compresses your voice less, but picks up more sounds in the room. It connects via XLR cord, so you'll need an interface to connect it to your computer.

Mic Arm

The Rode PSA 1 Swivel Mount rotates 360 degrees for precise mic placement. Just clamp it to your desk.

Headphones

The Sennheiser HD 280 Pro padded headphones are very comfortable and perfect for audio and video production. They plug into your interface device.

Windscreen & Shock Mount

The windscreen is customized for the AT2020 and the shockmount holds the microphone in the mic arm.

XLR Cord

This cord connects your microphone to your interface.

Scarlett 2i2

This interface plugs into your computer and allows you to connect up to two microphones via XLR cords.
